KELLER BEACH IMPROVEMENT GOALS

This project will update and improve the amenities at Keller Beach while honoring the original mid-century design aesthetic. Renovations will provide an accessible path of travel from the ADA parking at Miller Knox Shoreline all the way to the main terrace. Stormwater design will be brought up to code, invasive plants removed, and highly impacted planting areas will be restored to a native palette

Access

- Provide safe beach access for all visitors
- Provide an accessible path of travel from Miller / Knox Park
- Close a gap in surfaced Bay Trail
- Improve the drop-off zone and pedestrian entrance to Keller Beach Park along Dornan Drive

Utilities

- Update park restrooms and outdoor shower to accommodate current use levels and improved hygiene
- Update stormwater system and provide bio-treatment prior to discharge
- Provide water-wise, code compliant irrigation

Landscape

- Remove invasive species, reintroduce a native plant palette for habitat
- Improve soil health
- Provide durable, low-maintenance & aesthetic planting
- Screen roads and fences to improve Park visitor experience

Amenities:

- New ADA accessible restroom building
- 5 new grills and 10 Universal Design picnic tables
- Improved seatwalls and benches
- New fencing along Bay Trail
